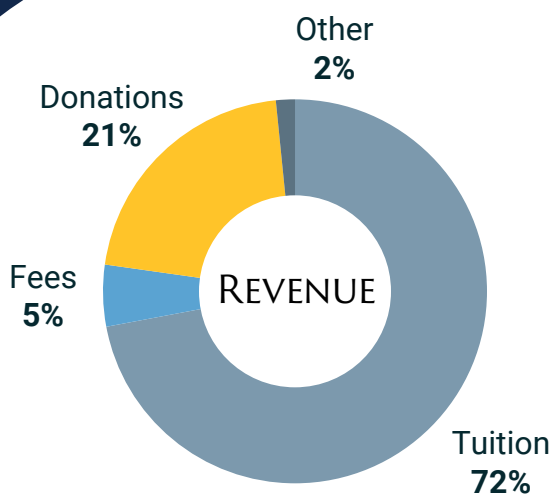

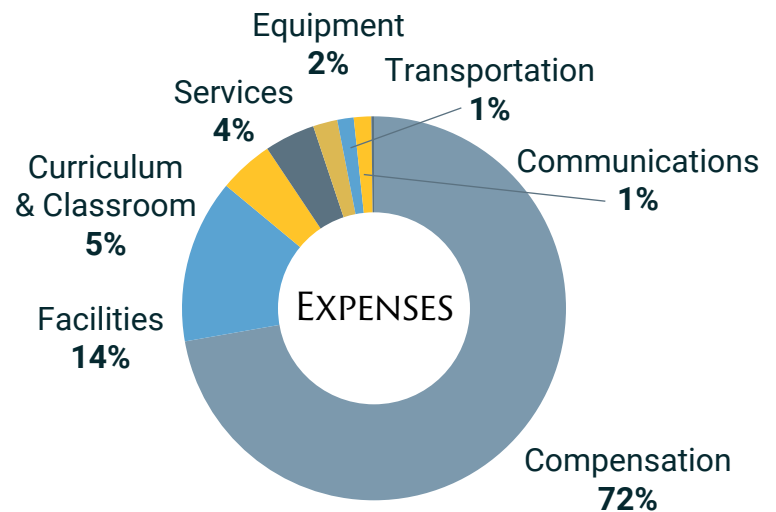


FINANCIAL SUMMARY

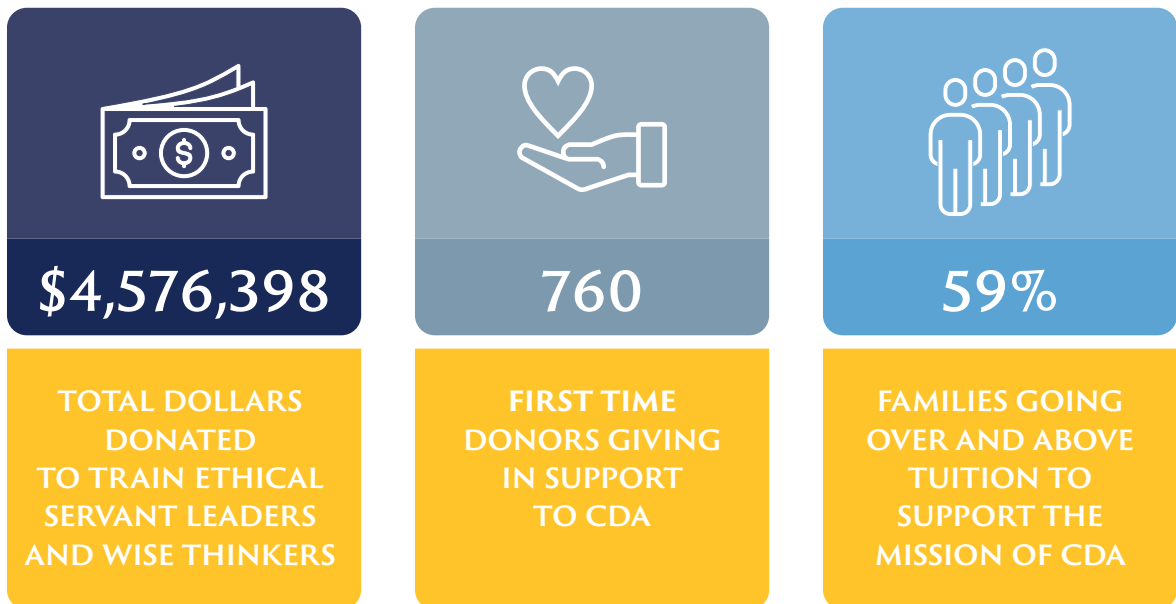

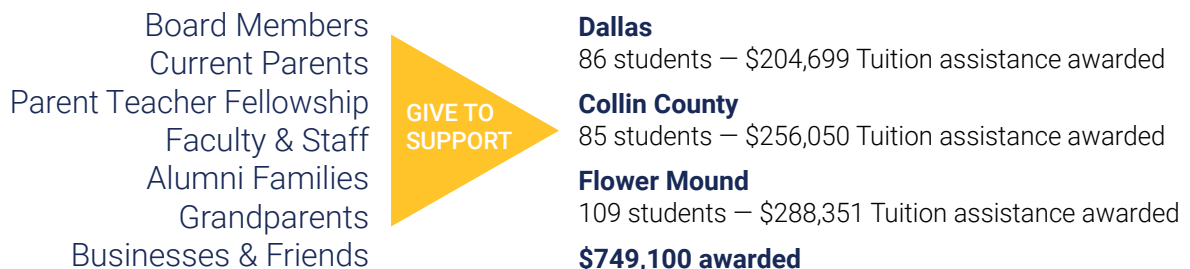

THE ANNUAL FUND AT WORK



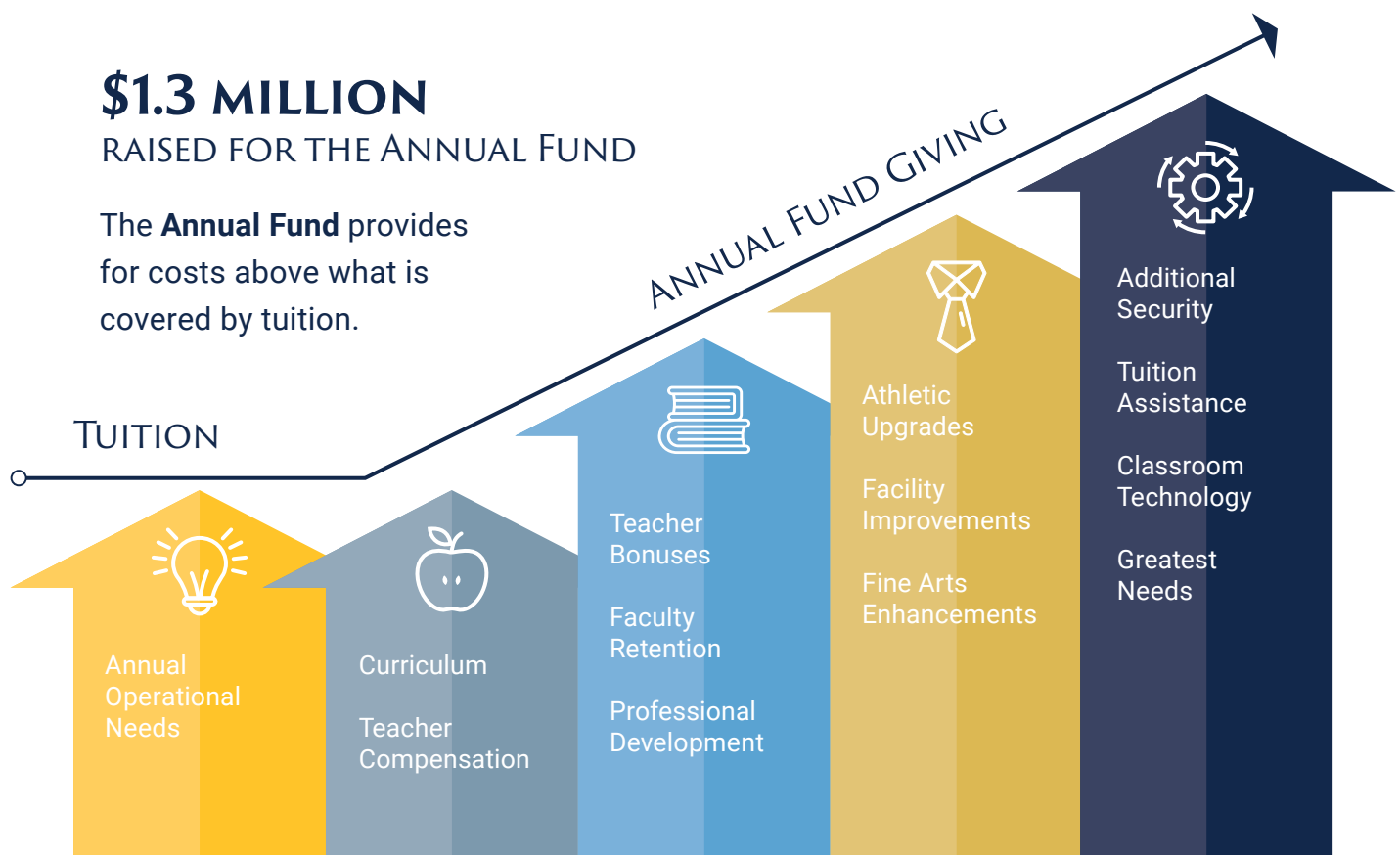
The Annual Fund provides for costs above what is covered by tuition.

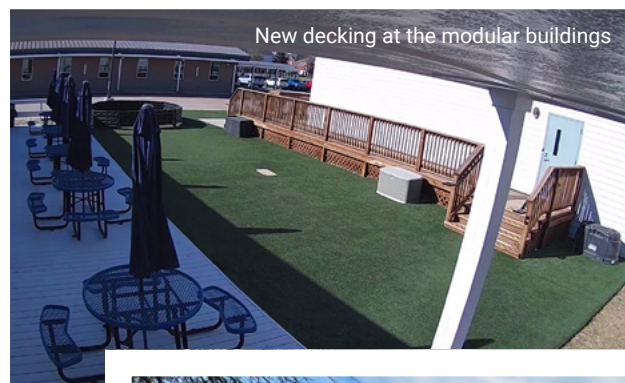


YOUR IMPACT CAMPUS BY CAMPUS

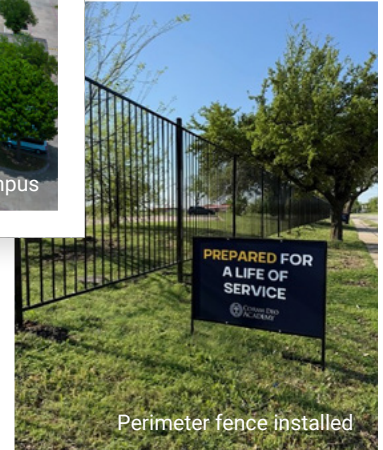
