

Eighth Grade Supply List 2025-2026

As you think ahead to eighth grade, consider what system you are going to use to organize your materials. We suggest using one of the following:

- Case-It or Trapper-Keeper style case with an individual folder for each class and rings for workbooks, notebooks, and a planner
- Individual, color-coded binders for each class

**A single folder is not appropriate to hold all of your handouts and notes in the eighth grade. You may try out different systems, but you must have some sort of plan!*

General supplies for all classes:

- ☐ Loose-leaf paper
- ☐ 2-3 packs of 3" x 3" Post-it notes
- ☐ Graph paper (4 squares to an inch)
- ☐ Zippered pencil case with the following:
 - ☐ Pencils
 - ☐ Blue, black, red, and green pens
 - ☐ Colored pencils
 - ☐ Several highlighters

Technology:

- ☐ 1 pair of wired earbuds or headphones

English:

- ☐ Separate, one-and-a-half-inch three-ring binder to be used exclusively for English *or* an English section in a larger three-ring binder (binder must have inside sleeves, folders, dividers)
- ☐ Dry erase markers and erasers
- ☐ Index cards

Science:

- ☐ Lined-paper notebook, preferably spiral with holes
- ☐ Sturdy plastic folder for storing worksheets, handouts, packets, etc. OR a dedicated section in a larger folder case
- ☐ Index cards to make flashcards (1-2 packs of 200)

History:

- ☐ College-ruled notebook
- ☐ A two-pocket folder or binder for storing worksheets, handouts, packets, and more OR a dedicated section in a larger folder case
- ☐ Index cards to make flashcards (*recommended but not required*)

World Language:***Chinese & Spanish***

- ☐ 1 Hard Cover Folder with Prong fasteners (3 - hole punched, letter size)
- ☐ 1 marble notebook for WL use only
- ☐ Earbuds (please pack them in your pencil case and bring them daily)

French

- ☐ 1 marble notebook for WL use only
- ☐ 5 Dry Erase markers to be packed in pencil case
- ☐ Earbuds (please pack them in your pencil case and bring them daily)

Math:***Algebra 1, 1B***

- ☐ Small 3-ring binder to be used exclusively for math
- ☐ Pocket folder for the binder
- ☐ Set of tab dividers
- ☐ Graph paper, 3-hole punched
- ☐ Pencils
- ☐ 12" plastic ruler (for use at home)

Geometry

- ☐ Large 3-ring binder exclusively for math
- ☐ pocket folder for the binder
- ☐ Set of tab dividers
- ☐ Graph paper, 3-hole punched
- ☐ Pencils
- ☐ 12" plastic ruler (for use at home)

Advisory

- ☐ A notebook- any style or design- OR an advisor section in a larger 3-ring binder

All items brought to school, including clothing, should be clearly marked with the student's name. Name tags on clothing are **highly recommended**, similar to those on

<https://www.namebubbles.com/>. Alternatively, you can write them with a laundry marker, such as Sharpie's Rub-A-Dub Laundry Marker.
