

Upper School Book Ordering

The school partners with BNC Services, a third-party online bookstore, to facilitate student book purchasing.

Book ordering for the MKA Upper School begins on Friday, August 1, 2025. You should receive your student's course enrollments on August 1, which you will need in order to determine and order the required books for each course.

BNC ships directly to your home for a flat rate of \$9.99. We encourage you to place your orders as soon as possible to ensure that your student has their books prior to the start of school.

Instructions for Ordering Books:

- Go to the <u>BNC Services website</u>
- If you are new to MKA, or have not previously used BNC, you will need to enter an Authentication Code, which is 2025.
- If you have used BNC in the past, you can login using the link highlighted in red (see screenshot below)



- Under "Select Term," choose "School Year 2025-2026" then click on Upper School and a list of possible courses will appear
- If your student's course is not listed, you do not need to purchase texts through BNC, MKA will supply these texts directly, or no text is required. For example, most World Language, math and science textbooks are supplied by the school and billed to your tuition account, and the courses are NOT listed on BNC.
- Select all the courses that your student is taking, then hit continue.
- In some cases, MKA provides textbooks, including online access, directly to students and bills their tuition account; those books and digital resources will not



be listed on the BNC page. If a textbook isn't listed for the name of your exact course (i.e. Geometry is not the same as Geometry Honors), then you will receive information for an online textbook once school starts. In those cases, there is no need to purchase anything before school starts.

• For Grades 11 and 12, second semester elective English course books will not be available for ordering until Thanksgiving, at which time the bookstore will be opened and you will be notified.

For most math and science courses, students will need access to WebAssign, My Lab, and/or Mastering. If access is required to complete a summer assignment, the corresponding class key/access code is listed on the summer assignment instructions. Otherwise, the teacher will provide this information in September. Students do not need to provide any kind of payment in order to create accounts in these online resources.
