VERACROSS PAY (VC PAY)

Marvelwood School uses Veracross VC Pay to make the payment process more convenient for parents. Payments via credit card or automatic payments can be made securely through the Veracross Parent Portal.

THREE PAYMENT PLANS

PLAN 1

Full tuition and fees (Total Financial Obligation) paid by May 1, 2026. Tuition Insurance is recommended but not required.

Early Bird Discount: A \$1,000 discount will be applied for payments made in full with the deposit by March 2, 2026. (Not applicable to financial aid recipients.)

PLAN 2

Tuition and Fees (Total Financial Obligation) are paid in two installments. Two-thirds of the tuition is due May 1, 2026, with the remaining balance due October 1, 2026. Tuition Insurance is required.

PLAN 3

Tuition and fees (Total Financial Obligation) are paid by making a 25% payment of total tuition and fees owed by May 1, 2026, with the remaining balance to be paid in eight (8) equal monthly installments beginning July 1st and ending February 1st. For students enrolling after July 1st, tuition payments will be adjusted to reflect monthly payments from enrollment through February 1st. Tuition Insurance is required for Plan 3.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

When a check is provided as payment, you authorize Marvelwood to either use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check.

Please note, Marvelwood will use information from your check to make an electronic fund transfer. Funds may be withdrawn from your account as soon as the same day you make your payment, and you will not receive your check back from your financial institution.

Tuition payment by credit card can be arranged through the Veracross Parent Portal. Please note that Marvelwood does not accept direct payments by credit card over the phone.

INCIDENTAL CHARGES (billed when incurred)

Laundry Fee: Marvelwood School offers a professional laundry service for student laundry and dry cleaning. These services are paid directly to the laundry service by the parent(s) or guardian(s). Laundry is optional.

Sports Alternatives: Marvelwood offers snowboarding, skiing, and equestrian as sports alternatives at an additional expense.

Special Activities: Field trips, such as trips to sporting events, plays, museums, and prom, are charged individually.

Tutoring: Academic subject tutoring may be arranged through the Academic Office and is charged hourly.

Standardized Testing: Marvelwood offers optional SAT and ACT Prep classes and testing for juniors and seniors, charged separately. More information is provided to families before each session.

Music Lessons: Music lessons may be arranged through the Academic Office and charged separately.
